



SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Homeless Assessment and Support Service (HAST)

The Homeless Assessment and Support Team provide access to healthcare and support services for homeless people in Sheffield with mental health problems.

1. ELIGIBILITY

The selection criteria for the above Service are applicable to:

- All adults irrespective of gender, age (18 years of age or over), ethnicity, sexuality, culture or physical abilities who are homeless and who have mental health problems.
- 16-17 year olds who are homeless and who have suspected or early onset psychosis.

Young people aged 16-17 who present to their GP/other services with common mental health problems will be referred to CAMHS for assessment and/or treatment.

2. THE REFERRAL PROCESS

Referrals are accepted from a wide range of agencies. Individual can also self-refer. Referral forms are available by contacting the team's office.

3. GEOGRAPHICAL POPULATION COVERED

- The registered population of NHS Sheffield Clinical Commissioning Group and individuals who do not have settled accommodation and meet the Service's criteria.
