Workplace Fire Safety Check



Workplace Managers have a responsibility to ensure that both fire preventative and precautionary measures employed throughout the work place by their employer (SHSC) remain 'fit for purpose' so far as they are reasonably able to determine within their professional capabilities. Managers should ensure that suitable arrangements are devised and implemented to monitor the fire safety measures within their work areas of responsibility. This Workplace Fire Safety Check has been devised to assist managers in monitoring and determining whether workplace fire safety measures are satisfactory, where the answer to a question is Yes' (√) and NO (X) remedial action must be undertaken to rectify any deficiencies identified.
